HOME on the High Street

HOME on the High Street is at the heart of our work at HOME Slough. It's a space to be creative, enjoy the creativity of others and to spend time with friends and family.

Our intention is that the space will be a mixture of programming of artists from across the UK, alongside the opportunity for local artists and community groups to utilise the space.

The time you will be able to access the space will be Monday – Sunday, 10am - 10pm.

We would like to invite artists and creative community groups to help us fill the space with fantastic experiences for the residents of Slough. We would like our local artists to share their work with residents.

We are looking for a range of arts and cultural activities, these could include one off events/performances, exhibitions, a series of workshops. Unlike many venues we won't have a team on site to support this work so anyone wanting to use the space will need to have enough capacity and resources to run the events themselves and have all the necessary good practice processes in place. We don't have a budget for this strand of activity.

We've pulled together the following thoughts on what we are looking for, and need, from community groups that use the space.

1. We are looking for creative activities that bring families together, particularly interactive events/workshops.
2. We want to put on activities and events that reach those in their 20s/30s who may not go to other arts events.
3. We want the majority of activities in the space downstairs to be open access so not exclusive for a small group of people.
4. Organisations and individuals who want to use the space need to have a track record of delivering the activities they are proposing. Please speak to one of the members of the team for advice on this.
5. Organisations and individuals will need to bring their own equipment and technical support as we have limited technical resources.

6. Anyone leading activity within the space will need to have public liability insurance and if leading activities with children and young people they will need DBS certificate in place.
7. If you are not charging for events, we will not charge you. If you intend to charge for events, we ask that you 'pay what you decide' for usage of the space, we are a charity and need to support our ongoing programme but also want to support others with their creative careers.
8. All events will need to have monitoring information collected, we need this so we can understand who is using the space and share this with our funders.
9. We would like to encourage all groups to be open to evaluation and feedback from audiences/participants and the HOME Slough team. We want to create an environment where we are learning together to create the best experiences for our audiences.

We will review all proposals regularly, we may not be able to provide a space to all those that apply but we will keep in touch to ensure that you don't miss out on other opportunities.
